A very nice selection of ballads, some that aren't included in any other of the too many collections I've gathered over the years. Most of the arrangements that I suspect are by Brent Edstrom have a really unique touch to them. Sophisticated, but very playable by a pianist at the intermediate level and beyond. One caveat; although Edstrom is listed as the arranger in the link, several of the songs are not arranged by Edstrom. A couple, Misty and Moon River, and one or two others, are in a collection I own arranged by Al Lerner, who's also a very skilled arranger,

but I mildly object to the minor bit of subterfuge. I'm taking a star away after further exploration of the contents. Fully 1/3 of the arrangements are from another Hal Leonard collection I already own. The description lead me to believe that all selections were arranged by Edstrom, and I really enjoy his arrangements. 24 of 25 people found the following review helpful.
