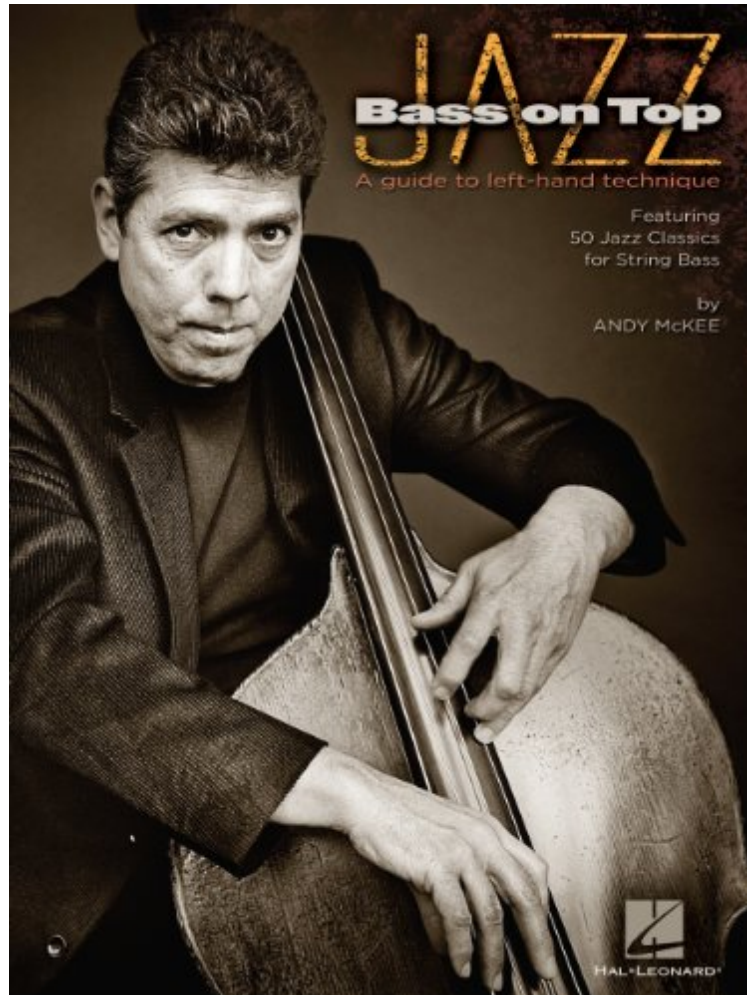

I already found benefit by reviewing the fingering choices for Night in Tunisia. What I do not understand, though, is that if the focus of the book is about developing good choices in fingering, why make the print so small that you can barely read it? I have less than perfect vision, like many people, but even with glasses it is still difficult to read the small numbers. The print should be on the level of the chord symbols in bold. I will have to pencil in everything to make it easily readable.
