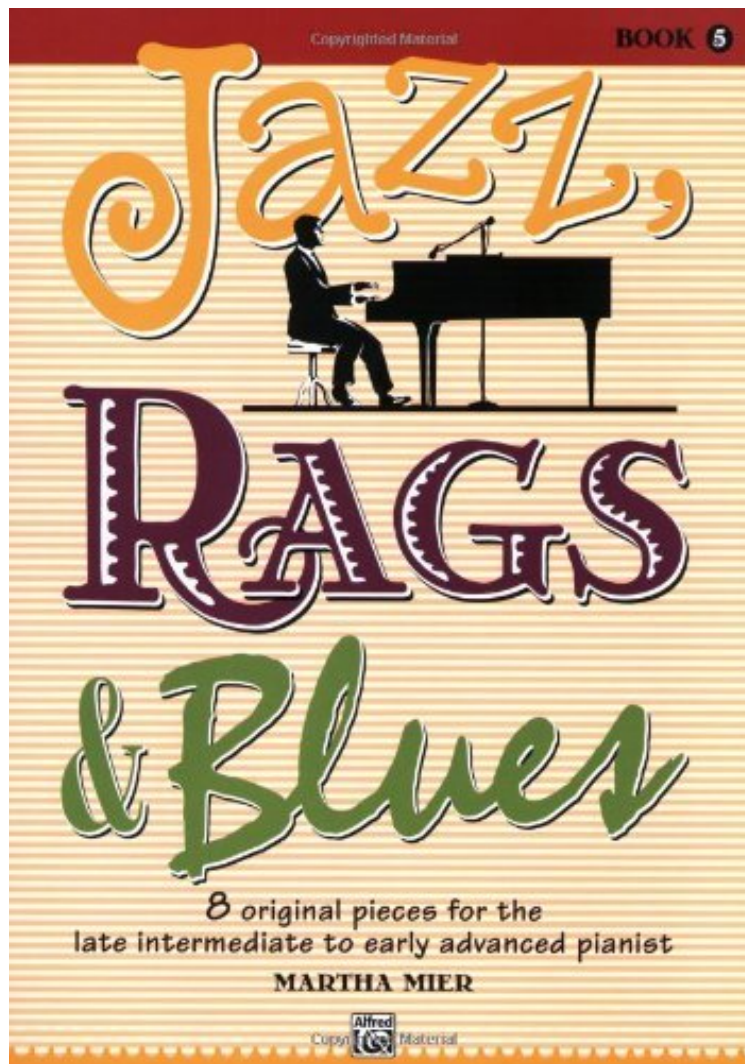

My son has used many of the books in the series of Jazz, Rags, and Blues books in his piano lessons and practice time. The songs are short and interesting, a fun change from the more traditional songs in the usual piano lesson books. In particular, many of these songs are great recital songs because they show off jazz, rags, or blues abilities in fun, short songs. The kids can demonstrate their abilities but not get bogged down in longer, trickier pieces. The series does increase in difficulty as the book numbers increase.
