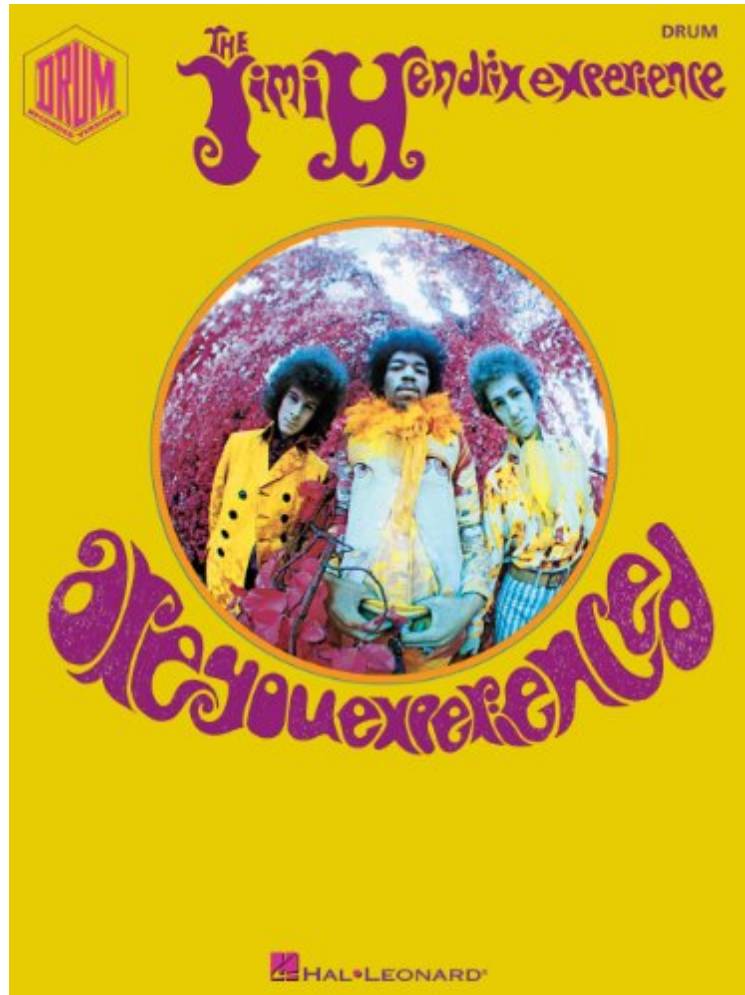

The book truly captures the low-budget backpacker's experience in India, mainly by pointing out how absurd situations and people can be. Sutcliffe's writing is astute and very funny, and Dave is likeable because his observations are honest and wry, exposing many pretentious and superficial stereotypes for what they are. I highly recommend this book, particularly if you have traveled in south-east asia (if not, you may not find it as funny).
