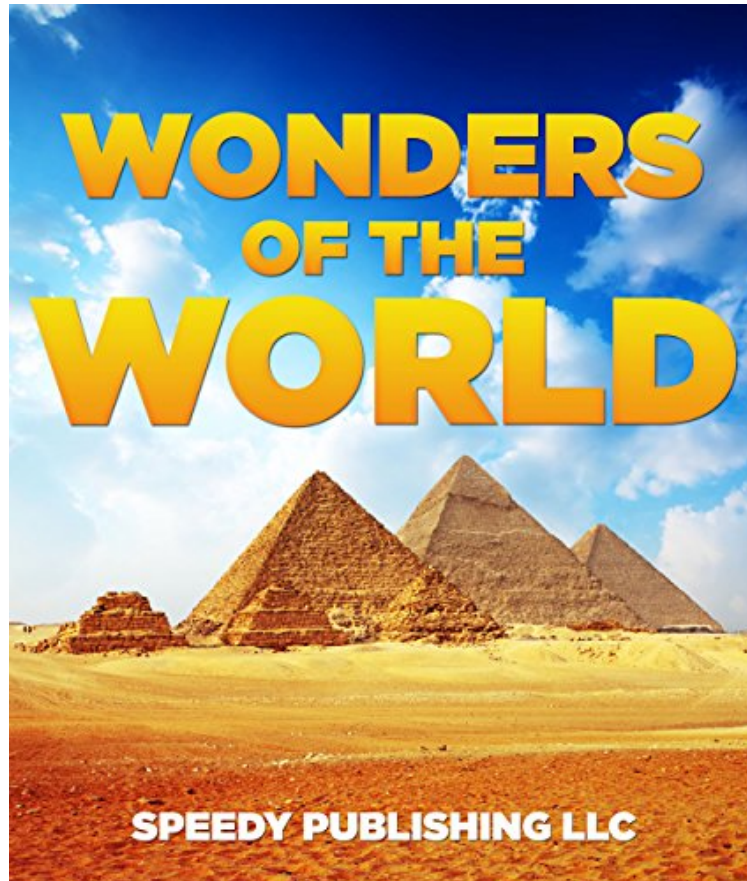

The illustrations were interesting, though in this book, the facts were more impactful. The book format really highlights the images and gives ample time for talking about the pictures. One spread has an image with a couple of sentences, then the next is simply an image. This repeats throughout the book and gives a great format for reading together. This book gives enough information to build a foundation, without being too in-depth or overwhelming. For us, it was random, for others, it would work well to start a unit about modern wonders. I also think this book would work well for a classroom, because there is a lot of opportunity for talking about the pictures, or even completing a written or drawing assignment.
