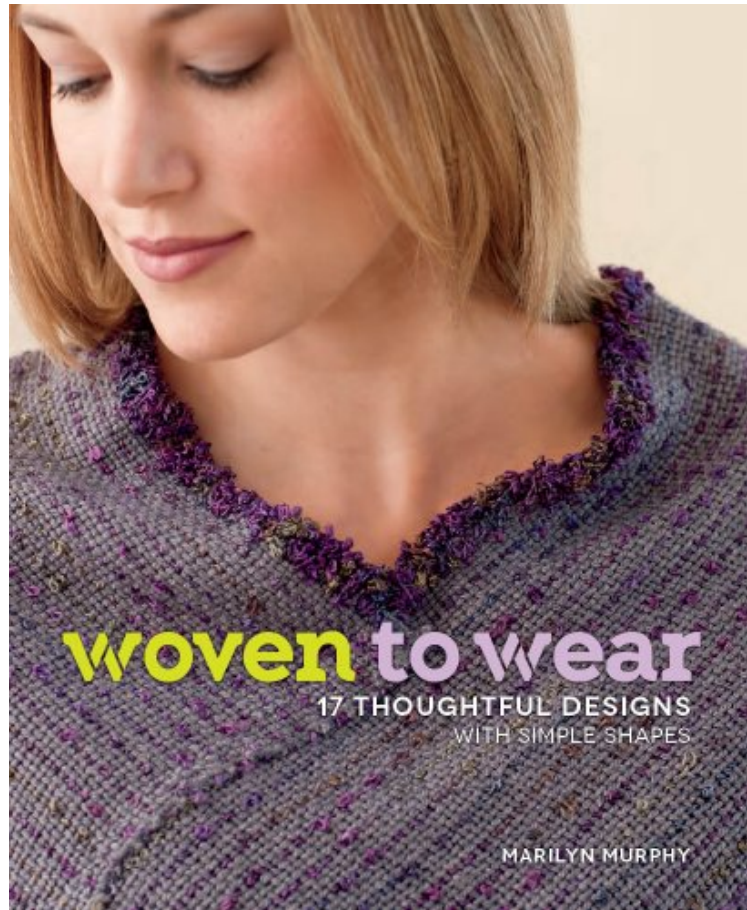


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## Woven to Wear: 17 Thoughtful Designs with Simple Shapes

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Handwoven wearables are hot! other techniques such as knitting and patchwork. The Woven to Wear designs are influenced by a global melting pot of traditional folkloric costume and ethnic fabric mixes in which silhouettes are roomy, layered, and flowing, and the cloth takes center stage.
