You will only find instructions for 12 tangles in the book. I have other Zentangle books that are just filled with patterns and this book is not like that.

What I like about the book is that it is filled with writing about Zentangle and that is something I did not have. I know there is lots of information online and I do lots of blog reading, etc. but it's still nice to settle in with a book. The writings are about how the author got started tangling along with in depth information on all kinds of different pens, pencils and paints I've heard about but didn't really know too many details on. After each pen, pencil or paint she talks about, there are a couple examples of tangles done with that one. I bought the Kindle edition and on my tablet it's really nice to zoom in and see all the detail of each type. There is a small section on shading and a large section on color. She also writes a lot about combining tangles with photography and again shows examples, a really informative chapter on tangles in journaling and a whole section on combining your tangles with different backgrounds in Photoshop. There are lots of examples of her work and then a little paragraph on what inspired that particular drawing. There are other contributors to the book besides the author and there is a little writeup on each person. The book ends with several links to blogs and places to buy supplies. Again, I would say if you are looking for instructions on how to do lots of different tangles, this book is probably not for you. But, if you want a really pretty book to inspire you, along with some very nice writing that definitely motivated me to try new things and may do the same for you, I'd say give this book a try. 4 of 4 people found the following review helpful. When I got it I thought that I wanted to learn a bunch of patterns, but this is actually better because now I know how to create my own patterns and incorporate Zentangle into a variety of art forms (everything from markers to painting to scrapbooking to digital art).
